Installation notes

Important:

- Hole excavation is minimum 3m x 3m square.
- If base is rocky or uneven you will require road or gravel base. Do not backfill with rocky soil as damage may occur.
- SA Department of Health regulations state the lid must sit above ground level at the seal.
- The Ri-Treat EP10 must be serviced quarterly by an authorised service agent. Ri-Industries can recommend a service agent in your area.
